ZOOMED-IN GAME

Divide players into teams, pairs, or let them compete individually.

The game's objective is to identify airport words shown on the slides.

Scoring for round is as follows:

- 1st zoom: 5 points
- 2nd zoom: 4 points
- 3rd zoom: 3 points
- 4th zoom: 1 point.

Aim to identify the word as early as possible to earn more points.

When a team or player is confident in identifying an activity, they should signal that they are ready to guess. If uncertain, proceed to the next zoomed-in slide. **Each team or player gets only one guess per round.** An incorrect guess means no further attempts in that round.

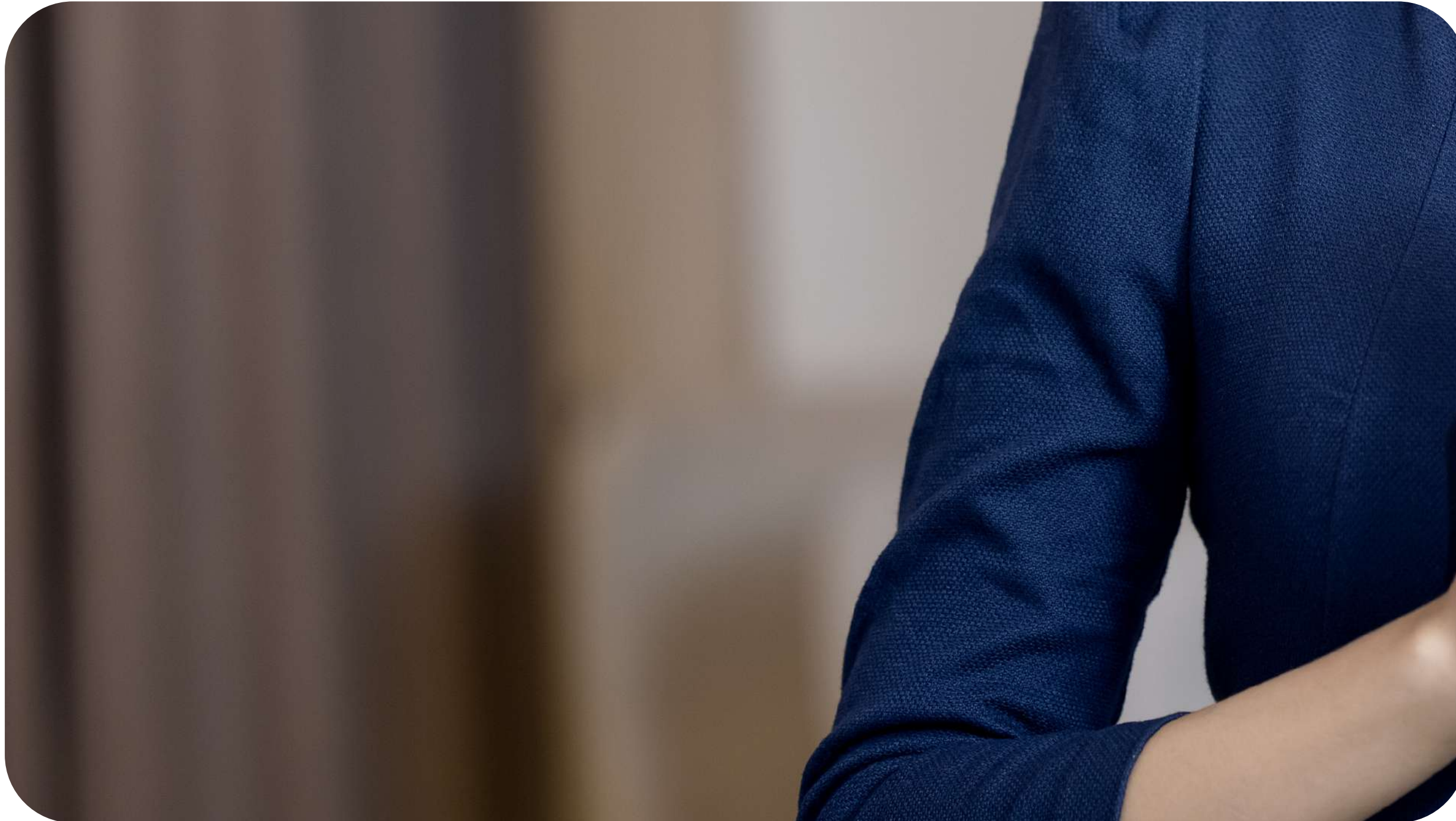
Points are given based on the accuracy of the answer and the zoom level at which the guess was made. Incorrect guesses earn no points

NEVER HAVE I EVER...

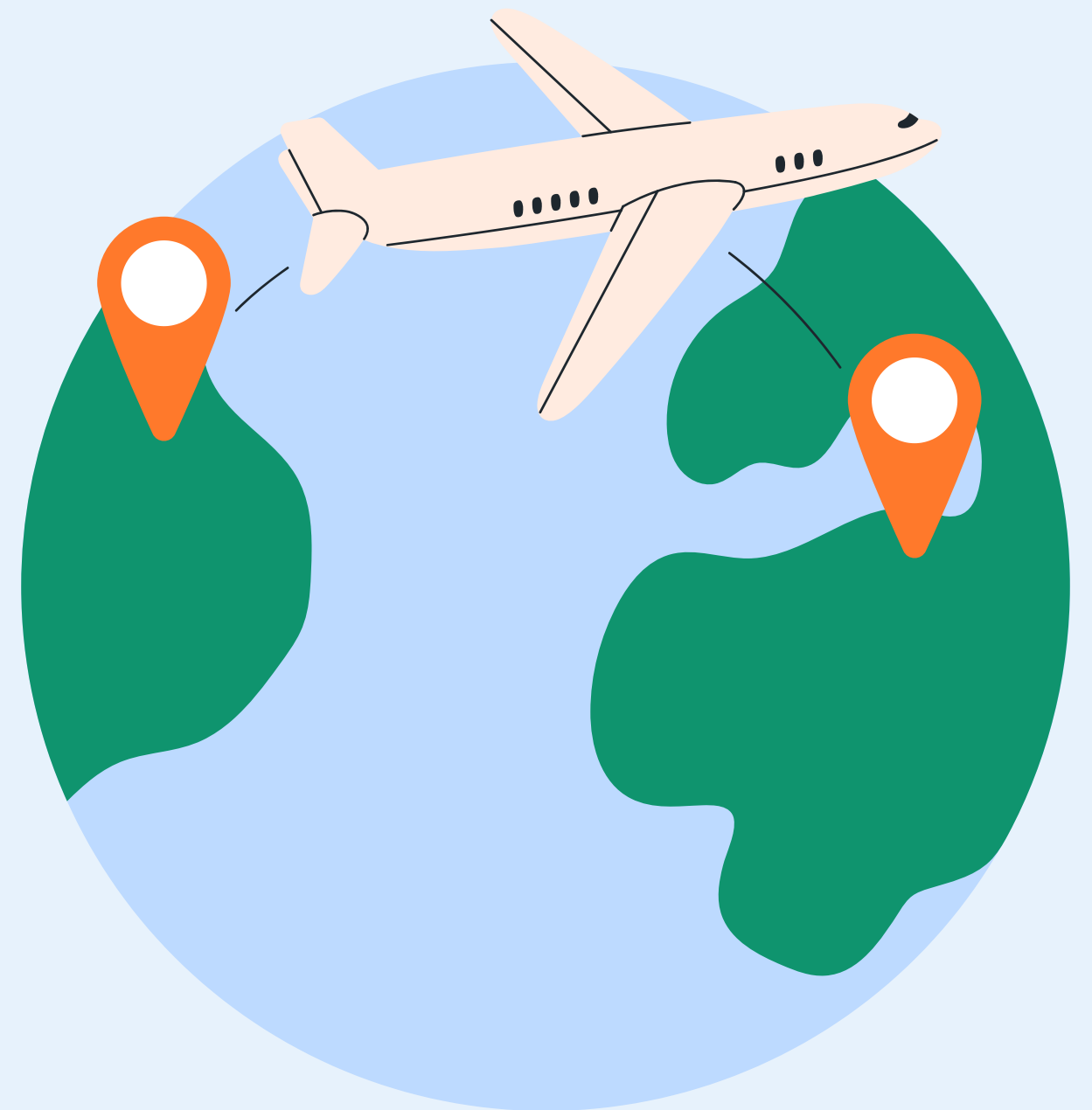
One person begins the game by saying 'Never have I ever...' and reading the sentence from the card.

Then, if it is true for them, other people say 'Yes, I have' or 'No, I haven't'. For example, 'Never have I ever lost my boarding pass at the airport.'

Anyone in the group who has done the action mentioned in the sentence has to bend one finger. The game continues with the next person in the group reading a 'Never have I ever' statement. Players who have done the action mentioned in the sentence continue to bend their fingers.

Players are eliminated from the game once they have bent all ten fingers. The last person with the most fingers still unbent wins the game.

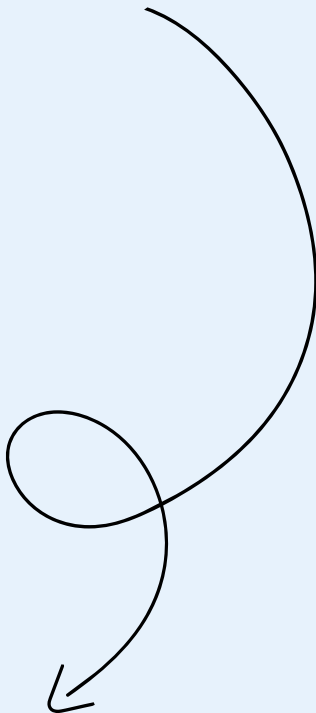

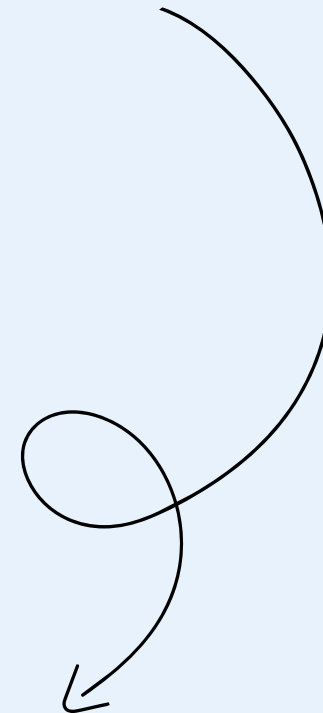

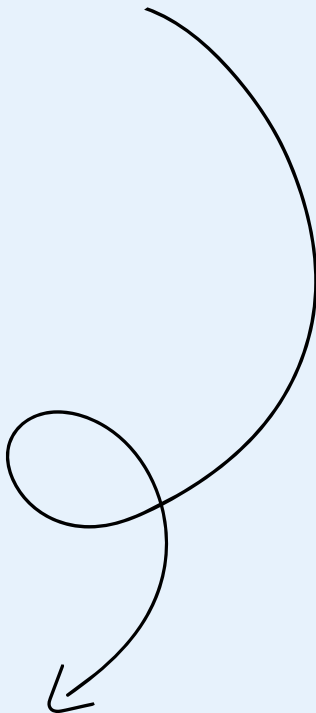

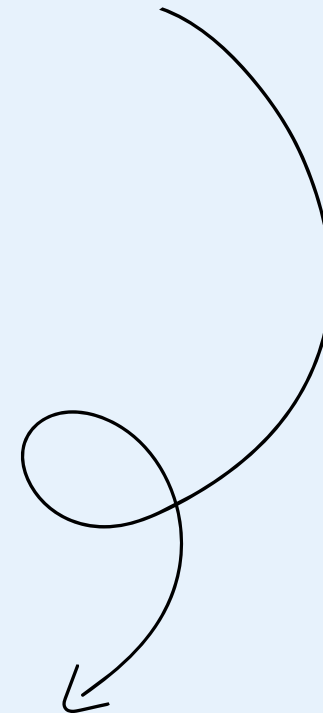

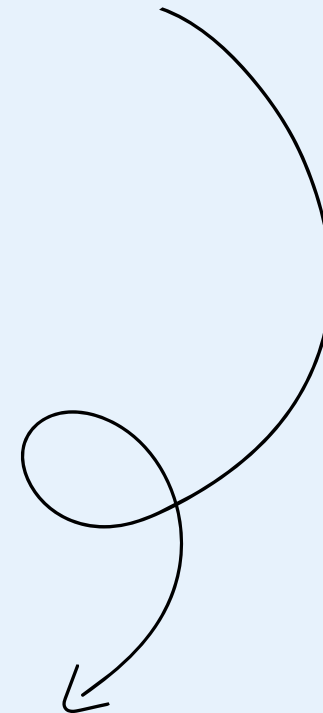
